## *Memories of War*

During my research into the various military graves and war memorials in St. Cuthbert's, particularly those in the parish church of St. Nicholas, I have received great assistance from the groundsman, Mr. David Taylor, without whose help this project wouldn't have been anywhere near as complete as it now is. I owe him a great debt of gratitude, as does the parish, for all the work he carries out in the churchyard to maintain the graves and grounds in such a wonderful condition - something he has been doing for many years. His knowledge of the church, the graves and the parish is likely to be unsurpassed.

The project of documenting the military graves at St. Cuthbert's has taken far longer than I usually spend on a project of this nature. There have been a number of reasons for this; one being the number of personnel remembered in this grave yard which is greater than many others I've so far researched. This was particularly the case for those lives remembered from The Great War, which are documented elsewhere on the website connected with this.

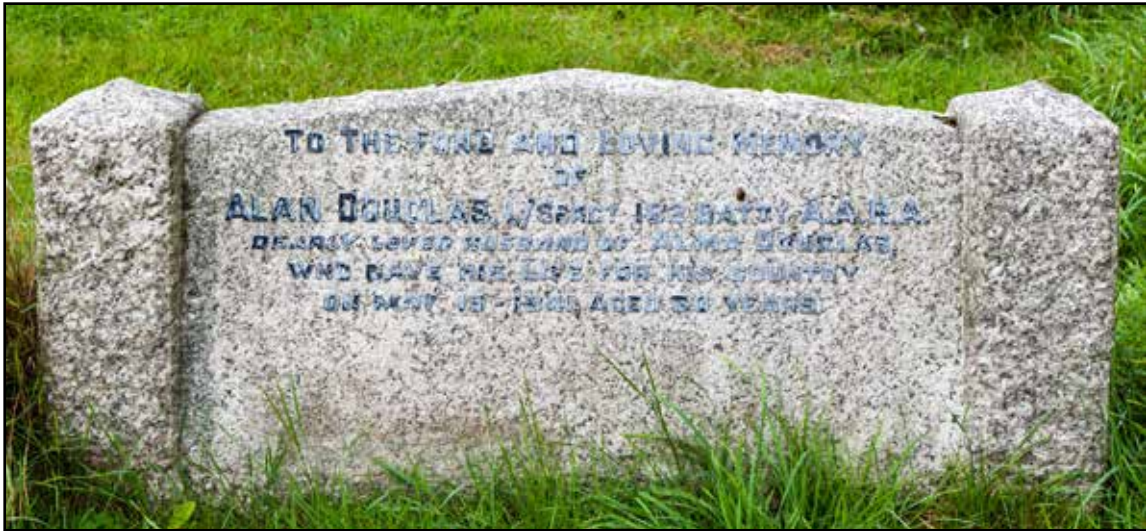

## A Request to the Parish Council and Parishioners

One of the anomalies that exist in many parishes is the fact that there are some omissions in the names inscribed on the war memorials compared with those in the churchyard. This is noticeable when one visits the churchyard and observes the names on the headstones of the graves and memorials of those killed in, or who died later because of their injuries, following both World Wars and who are not listed on the war memorials. The parish would render a great service to the families of those war heroes from the village if there was a common memorial that included all the names of these victims of war. Obviously, many casualties of wars never return home and are buried in other countries or have no known grave, although many of those are at least remembered on war memorials in both the UK and overseas. Others will be buried or remembered elsewhere in the United Kingdom.
